Clean Sky has proven to be the European flagship for reducing the environmental footprint of aviation for our future generations. Clean Sky 2 will start in 2014 and will proceed to calls for core partners and calls for partners. It will build on the current Clean Sky programme. While being focused on high TRL, integrated demonstrators, it will also include longer-term activities. In this context, the role of academia is more essential than ever.

Clean Sky 2 and the EASN Association are organizing a joint Workshop which will take place in Brussels on the 23rd of January 2014 at the premises of Clean Sky JU. The purpose of the workshop is to discuss how the Academia can optimise their participation, as Core Partners in consortia or clusters, or as Partners; and to identify ways of giving the necessary room for innovative, bottom-up proposals and approaches, in the framework of the Technical Proposal.

This will be accomplished by a series of presentations from CS representatives, with reference to the possibilities for academia for participation in CS2 clusters and the envisaged calls for proposals. A panel discussion will follow, in which representatives of CS2, EASN and the EC will take place and engage in an open dialogue with the workshop participants.

The active participation of Academics from all European countries is mostly encouraged and can only prove beneficial for all parties involved.
